DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES OF **SCHOOL APPOINTMENTS**

1. SCHOOL CADET CAPTAIN

School Cadet Captain is responsible to the Senior Master for the Following:

1. To be role model and lead by example in punctuality, turnout, respect to elders, manners, public speaking, impartiality and other aspects of discipline and courage.
2. To ensure that all the School Appointments perform their duties properly and ensure that their conduct and behaviors is exemplary.
3. To pass orders to House Captains and other appointments which he receives from School Staff, especially Principal, Vice Principal Adm. Officer and Senior Master. To pass instructions of the officers, to the school, during Roll Call.
4. To ensure that the cadets are correctly dressed and punctual at the Mess, for classes, Assembly, Games, Roll Call etc.
5. To assist the Senior Master and the staff during function and VIP visits.
6. To ensure that the activities of the School progress smoothly even when there is no staff at supervision. To ensure arrangements for the School Assembly, flag Hoisting, CCA, Cultural, sports function etc are made. To ensure that the cadet responsible for various activities including cadet- officials are detailed in advance.
7. To ensure that in the School, no activity occurs which is detrimental to the interest of the School, In the event of any violation of the school rules or any disturbance, the School Cadet Captain is to control the situation with the help of the other School Appointments and also report to the Duty Master / Senior Master immediately.
8. To ensure that no cadet leaves the School Campus without proper authority.
9. To ensure that cadets pay proper compliments to the staff and ladies and wish them whenever they meet/pass by.
10. To ensure that the School flag is hoisted and lowered in time.
11. To impress on the cadets the need for self discipline.
12. To be Present at the forefront of all school events.
13. To instil discipline among cadets with the help of School Cadet Vice-Captain and other School and House appointments.



14. To Carry out the responsibilities of the School Cadet-ViceCaptain during the latter's absence.
15. To handover Parade State in time to the Duty Master at all Roll Calls and Assemblies.
16. To say School Prayer during assembly and Grace during meal.
17. To project the problems of the Cadets, including those related to health and homesickness, fitness, academics, administration, discipline etc.
18. To meet the officers before lunch time everyday and apprise them of the problems and activities as well as to take down instructions for the rest of the day and the next day.
19. To inform the Duty Master and Officers of any unusual happening or event like homesickness, depression, rebelliousness, continued sickness, etc: any incident of indiscipline like a fight, quarrel, ragging, mutiny, theft, forgery, late-coming, absenteeism, skipping meals, malingering, littering, Visiting out of bound places, consuming alcohol, smoking, using electronic gadgets, malpractice in exams, disobedience of orders etc even if it involves own classmates.
20. To under takes tree plantation and tending to saplings with the helps of the House captains.
21. Counselling defaulting cadets to follow rules and regulations : in the case of repeated offenders report to the Vice Principal / Adm. Officer/ Senior Master for further constructive action.
22. To handle problems which are within one s' capacity and attempt to find the solutions with help of the Staff and Management.
23. To keep the campus green and clean.
24. To Guide the junior appointments in carrying out their responsibilities.
25. To lead the School Parade on ceremonial occasions.
26. To initiate Mess Meeting, Premier Class Review Conferences etc. periodically.
27. To motivate young visitors to join the School and NDA.
28. To carry out any other duty assigned by School authorities.
29. To carry out other duty of opening of the doors of the Mess for entry of cadet for meals.



2. SCHOOL CADET VICE CAPTAIN

School Cadet Vice-Captain is responsible to the Senior Master for the following :-

1. To be a role model and lead by example in punctuality, turnout, respect to elders, manners, public speaking, impartiality and other aspects of discipline and courage.
2. To promote self discipline amongst cadets.
3. To be present at the forefront of all school events.
4. To ensure that the cadets wake up in time and also go to bed by Light - Out time.
5. To ensure that the cadets report everywhere in time.
6. To ensure that the cadets are properly dressed according to the uniform of the day.
7. To ensure that the cadets march properly in squads on the road.
8. To ensure that the cadets follow Mess Etiquettes and Table Manners.
9. To ensure that the cadets bath themselves and wash their undergarments everyday.
10. To ensure that the cadets pay compliments and respect to all the elders at the School.
11. To ensure that the cadets don't indulge in acts of vandalism or destruction of public or private property.
12. To ensure that the cadets don't indulge in ragging of any sort, especially physical manhandling and use of abusive language.
13. To carry out the duties and responsibilities of the School Cadet Captain in the latter's absence.
14. To listen to the problems of the cadets and attempt to solve them with the help of the Staff and Management.
15. With the help of the House Captains, ensure cadets maintain silence during an event.
16. To inform the Duty Master and Officers of any unusual happening or event like homesickness, depression, rebelliousness, continued sickness, etc, any incident of indiscipline, like a fight, quarrel , ragging, mutiny , theft, forgery, late-coming, absenteeism, skipping meals, malingering, littering, visiting out of bound places, consuming alcohol,



smoking, using electronic gadgets, malpractice in exam, disobedience of orders etc even if it involves own classmates.

17. To guide the junior appointment in carrying out their responsibilities.
18. To carry out any other duty assigned by the School authorities.
19. To carry out other duty of opening of the doors of the Mess for entry of cadet for meals.

3. HOUSE CAPTAIN & PREFECT

A House Captain is responsible to the House Master for the following :-

1. To be a role model and lead by example in punctuality, turnout, respect to elders, manners, public speaking, impartiality and other aspects of discipline and courage.
2. To promote self discipline amongst cadets.
3. To ensure that the cadets wake up in time at reveille.
4. To check the turnout and haircut (ensure haircut of a cadet twice in a month of the cadets before proceeding to any place.
5. To ensure that the cadets reach in time for all events and assemblies.
6. To handover Parade State in time to the School at all Roll Calls (PT, Games, Prep, Night Roll Call etc) and Assemblies. A Parade State Chit will be used for the purpose.
7. To give daily report to the House Master during Night Roll Call.
8. To ensure that a buddy system is maintained within the House, wherein four cadets who live in proximity are part of a buddy group.
9. To maintain discipline and order of the Housemaster inside and outside the hostel. It include the following :-
 - a) To ensure punctuality at all assemblies, roll call, meals etc.
 - b) To ensure cadets are appropriately dressed for each occasion.
 - c) To ensure that the cadets maintain proper kit layout after waking up every morning.
 - d) To ensure that the Hostel and its premises are kept clean always through shramdaan (especially on Sundays between 0700 and 0800 hrs) and by not permitting the Cadets to litter the place.
 - e) To ensure that the cadets wake up in time and also go to bed by Lights Out time.



- f) To ensure that the cadets march properly in squads on the road.
 - g) To eat with the Housemates and to ensure that the cadets follow Mess Etiquettes and Table Manners.
 - h) To ensure that the cadets pay compliments and respect to all the elders at the School.
 - i) To ensure that the cadets don't indulge in act of vandalism or destruction of public or private property.
 - j) To ensure that the cadets don't indulge in ragging of any sort, especially physical manhandling and use of abusive language.
 - k) To ensure that the cadets participate in PT, Games, NCC, Club and other activities.
 - l) To ensure that the cadets of another House don't enter the dorm without the permission of the Housemaster.
 - m) To ensure that cadets of another House don't tease or trouble own Housemates and vice versa.
 - n) To ensure that housemates speak only in English and also read books of English.
 - o) To conduct public speaking exercise during Night Roll Call.
 - p) To ensure that the cadets who are detailed for Assembly Talk, News reading, Debate and Group Discussion are all practiced well. This is applicable to the preparation of all other events/competitions.
10. To inform the Duty Master and officers/Housemaster/Hostel Supdt. of any unusual happening or event like homesickness, depression, rebelliousness, continued sickness, etc: any incident of indiscipline like a fight, quarrel, smoking using electronic gadgets, malpractice in exams, disobedience of orders etc even if it involves own classmates.
11. To report absentee cadets who are unwell to the Housemaster Everyday.
12. To carry out the following events even in the absence of House Master/Hostel Supdt/Any other Teacher.
(a) Reveille (b) House PT (c) Prep (d) Night Roll call (e) Light out
13. To ensure that the Housemates devote sufficient time for academic pursuits in order to improves their own and the House's performance in academic.



14. To select teams for various competitions involving sports & Games, co curricular and other activities and ensure that these teams practice adequately for the competitions.
15. To assist the House Master in compiling and publishing articles and photographs in the House Newsletter.
16. To ensure good harmonious relationship with other House Appointments.
17. To lead the House Troop on Parade.
18. To guide junior / Feeder House Captains in carrying out their responsibilities and the latter are to seek advice and counsel from the Senior House Captain.
19. To carry out any other duty assigned by School authorities.

4. SCHOOL PREFECT

The school prefect is expected to carry out all the duties of School Captain in his absence.

7. Be pure in thought & deed, courteous & polite in conduct with the subordinates and the weak.
8. Do not lie, cheat, steal or abet the same.
9. Feel pride in being a cadet of this school and avail of opportunities offered by the school.
10. Your honour is supreme and place service before self.



GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. Cadets are strictly forbidden from leaving the school premises.
2. Do not move in the corridor or outside class room during school hours. Always be punctual and properly dressed.
3. Do not carry valuables and costly items with you.
4. Keep a clean handkerchief.
5. Shoes should be polished everyday.
6. all the cadets must take care of their belongings in the house.
7. Any breakage in the house must be immediately reported to the hostel superintendent/House master and in the class to the respective class teachers.
8. No cadets should play inside the house/house premises.
9. Cadets must not take any food item with them from school mess to the house.
10. Cadets must march to dining hall with their respective house captains in a flight.
11. No cadet should move from the mess before the grace by the school captain.
12. Do not waste food.
13. Do not cross the play fields/lawns/parks.
14. Do not keep transistors, mobile, cameras, musical instruments or any valuable and costly items, any electric gadgets in the dorms. If such items are found in the dorms, the same will be confiscated and disciplinary action will be taken against the offender.
15. Point to point movement must be in squads.
16. Cadets proceeding on leave must carry leave certificates.
17. Cadets will carry the School Calendar with them throughout the day except during the PT and Games periods.
18. In case of loss of Calendar, the Cadet should report immediately to the Class Teacher / House Master.



A WORD TO THE PARENTS

1. Parents/guardians are permitted to meet their wards on the day of PTM during timings between : 1000-1300 Hrs. in respective class room.
2. Parents are requested to watch carefully their ward's progress in academics and outdoor activities.
3. Parents are requested to meet the house Master if the student performance is not satisfactory.
4. The student are required to score 33% in each subject for promotion. However the Students are required to score 45% in each subject and 55% in aggregate to retain the scholarship.
5. The Examination for the Classes (VI-XI) would be conducted as per the Remodeled assessment structure in accordance with CBSE Guidelines.
6. A student has to get atleast a pass grade in Art Education (drawing and painting), Computer and Environment Education for promotion to next higher class.
7. Parents are requested to have regular correspondence with their ward in order to keep themselves fully apprised of the progress of their ward.
8. Parents have to ensure that their wards meticulously follow the booking out and booking in schedule.



9. Parents are requested to send their wards back to school after each break or vacations as per scheduled time. A fine of Rs. 200/- per day will be charged for unauthorized absence by student.
10. Parents are requested not to visit classes and dorms.
11. No leave will be sanctioned other than Authorized vacation and Emergencies.
12. As far as possible parents should meet their ward's House Master, Class Teacher, Subjects Teacher. during PTM's.
13. It is mandatory for the parents of students of all classes to attend PTM's.
14. Parents to ensure that their ward reports to school on time after vacation break.
15. Any boy reporting back late after break/vacation, will report along with the Parents even if with medical certificate (M.C to be from civil Hospital/Govt. Hospital) before 1330 hrs. on school working days.



RULES OF SCHOOL LIBRARY

1. Maintain silence in the School Library.
2. Any book lost/torn must be informed to the Librarian immediately and the book lost by the borrower shall have to be replaced within 15 days time from the date of loss by the borrower.
3. Each Borrower is supposed to examine the condition of the book when it is issued and has to ensure that the damage if any, is mentioned in the loan register.
4. While returning the book, the borrowers will ensure that the date of return is correctly entered and each entry is signed by the Librarian.
5. Stealing of book / magazines from the school library is a serious offence. If a student is caught stealing / tearing / damaging book / magazines from the library if he does not return issued book from the library, he will have to pay double the cost of the book



THE SCHOOL EMBLEM

the school Emblem came into being with inception of the school in the year 1961. It has a shield as its background, the alphabets 'SSK' are embossed on it. These are the abbreviation for Sainik School Kunjpura, In the Centre of the shield we have four stripes of green, red, yellow and blue representing the colours of the four Houses Chillianwala, Kurukshetra, Panipat and Thaneshwar. The boys are divided into four houses in order to inculcate a spirit of competition.

We have the school motto 'Siddhim' Sannadh' inscribed on the Emblem, which means 'ready to accomplish'. It aptly expresses an Ideal of conduct appropriate to an educational institution of this kind. These words also appear in the Hindi School Song, and keep echoing in the tender minds of the young Kunjeans while preparing them to face the ordeals of life more resolutely.

Sainik School Kunjpura, stands majestically sprawled on 275 Acres, amidst nature's beauty in the land of 'Mahabharata' where Lord Krishna discoursed and enlightened 'Arjuna' with the knowledge of 'Geeta'. The school, which is about 10 Kms away fromt the heart of Karnal City - The 'Karna Bhumi' was originally the mansion of the Nawab of Kunjpura, Mohammad Ibrahim Khan, who had built it in 1900 AD to house the marriage party of his daughter. This huge building was earlier the 'sanctum sanctorium' of the prestigious 'Punjab Police Academy.

Sainik School Kunjpura came into being on the 24th of July, 1961 at the behest of the then Defence Minister of the country, Shri V.K. Krishna Menon who took personal interest in its inception and upbringing. Late Col.E.J. Simeon an able administrator nurtrured it for seven long years as its 'Founder Principal'. Gradually, over a period of time lot of additions were made - the Junior Block, The Infirmary, the Cadets Mess, the Manekshaw Auditorium, the Semeon Squash Court, the Swimming Pool and the residential area for the staff and the boys but the 'Main Building' remained the 'nerve center' of the school with the Administrative Block, Senior Classrooms, Computer cum conference room, Library, General Knowledge room, Staff room in its vicinity.



The student are administered through the house system. All students are allocated to one of the four Houses. These are known as Chillianwala, Kurkshetra, Panipat and Thaneshwar, However in their first year of schooling, the are divided only into two House, i.e. Chhamb constituting the Thaneshwar and the Panipat and Shakargarh, constituting the Kurukshetra and the Chillianwala. In Class VII they join their repective House. Each House is looked after by a House Master and Tutors.
